Section 2 Summary of activity & centre staff met

2.1 General comments regarding the day including good practice. For a support visit outline advice, guidance & training provided

This was the External Quality Assurers (EQA) first visit to the centre since allocation to the centre. The visit itself was a routine visit requested by the City and Guilds managing office.

The visit began with the EQA providing centre staff with an update on the latest City and Guilds electrotechnical award developments. in particular discussion was held over the development work currently underway for the provision of 2394/95 dated entry exams becoming on demand. Additionally, the centre requested cl arification on the 2397 award in respect of actual on-site experience requirements. The EQA requested the centre forward details of their proposals for delivery in respect of this. The EQA agreed to request further clarification on this and will feedback to the centre.

Additionally, the centre explained the previous EQA had agreed to dispensation arrangements for candidates undertaking the 2395-01 unit 303 practical rig test requirements for those candidates already holding the 2394-01 award and having achieved it within the last 6 months. The EQA noted he was not aware of any formal agreement at a national standardisation level for this arrangement, but would again follow this up for clarification and feedback to the centre. A particular query regarding this would be around the time allowance given.

Given the high quality of both documented assessment evidence coupled to the positive outcome from assessor/IQA observation by the EQA, the EQA recommends 2377-22, 2394-01, 2395-01 and 2396-01 are allset to 'Low' risk - Full approval.

2377-22 - Candidate evidence was of a good standard and was appropriately assessed, there was evidence of good use of written feedback to the candidates with clear IQA records were thorough and reflected good sample planning and reporting.

2396-01 - The EQA witnessed the assessor providing assessment feedback to two 2396-01 candidates - Martin Jones and Philip Alton on their 2396-01 Unit 401 progress. The candidates are yet to complete the full award. This is appropriate.

The assessor put the candi dates at ease and explained the purpose and process of the feedback. The assessor had provided written feedback statements and used the meeting to fully discuss the required areas. The feedback to candidates was a suitable balance of technical discussion and encouragement. This activity was followed by an IQA verification of the assessment that had just been undertaken. Both IQA and assessment were ofa high standard.
