Must provide evidence of work carried out to be able to demonstrate 2 years competence for the scope for which they have applied.
6	Existing or previously recognised <i>Qualified Supervisors</i> registered within last two years with the Current Level 3 Award in the Requirements for Electrical Installations	Letter or similar from the previous <i>Scheme</i> provider confirming previous status and must provide evidence of work carried out to demonstrate practical competence for the scope for which they have applied.
